<p>Who can apply for the 2021 part of the DWC finals competition?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any dancer who attended the 2021 country qualifier of their country and obtained a mark of 70 or above. • Any dancer whose country does not hold a qualifier or has not been able to hold one in 2021 and has requested to qualify by video entry for DWC and has received a qualified mark <p><u>Video entries must be submitted to DWC no later than 01 March 2021.</u></p>
<p>Event Fee:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Event fee for 2021 competition: 60 euro for the 2021 competition. <p>If you are competing in both the 2020 and the 2021 competition, the event fee will be 90 euros per dancer which will cover both competitions.</p> <p><u>This is a compulsory fee*</u></p> <p><u>Membership fees for 2021 are 12 euros per dancer</u></p>
<p>Dance Fees:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 60 euro per solo • 30 euro duet/trio (per dancer) • 20 euro group (per dancer)
<p>Closing dates and Payments for final entries;</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each country will have a specific closing date in 2021 for their entries to be in the DWC system. Payment for the finals entries must be paid once the entry has been registered on the system. If payment has not been received by this closing date, then DWC has the right to offer the spaces to another school on the waiting list.

Cancellation of entries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please note, cancellation by a dance school once payment has been made cannot be refunded unless due to a medical condition and covered by a medical letter.
Age requirements for 2021 competition:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All ages are based on the age as of 01 January 2021.
Country entries 2021:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For 2021 all countries can have up to four spaces per class. The Qualifying mark for entry to the DWC finals is 70 and above. The four highest marked routines performed at the qualifier for each class, confirming to attend the DWC finals, will be accepted. Should spaces become available within this four, after the closing date, the qualifier organiser will offer the spaces to the next routines in line that have obtained 70 marks or above.
Soloists 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Soloists can enter a maximum of 5 solos. <p><u>The solos cannot be in the same class.</u></p>
Country/Venue for 2020/2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will hope to advise all dance schools when and where the competition will be held by the end of September/early October 2020. This of course is dependent on whether countries have recovered from Covid-19 and are allowing travel.
Dates for 2020/2021 competition:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are looking into dates anytime in between: 25 June and 13 August 2021.

	<p>We hope to advise all dance schools of the confirmed dates by the end of September/early October 2020.</p>
Schedule 2021:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A provisional schedule will be released no later than 01 March 2021 for the 2021 part of the competition.
Galas:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be holding 4 galas for the 2021 competition. 1 x theatrical and 1 x classical for the mini and children section and 1 x theatrical and 1 x classical for the junior and senior section.
Personal insurance:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It is the responsibility of each family to take out travel insurance for travel and accommodation.
Possible cancellation:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the final event has to be cancelled again, DWC will refund all monies that has been paid in the form of credit notes for future competitions.
General:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DWC reserves the right to amalgamate the 2020 and 2021 competition if we do not receive enough registrations to hold two separate competitions. • The same choreography performed in the 2020 competition cannot be performed again in the 2021 competition <p>All communications regarding the 2021 competition must be directed via your qualifier organiser. If your country does not have a qualifier organiser then please contact DWC directly at dance@dwcworld.com</p> <p>*The Event fee is a compulsory fee which is per dancer and this covers the opening ceremony, photos and videos of the dancer, live streaming, DWC app, access to theatres and the gala parties.</p> <p>DWC reserve the right to add to these conditions as we see how the world economic situation develops. We confirm that the dance fees and event fee will remain the same as published.</p>
